Powell McCormick spent 16 years at Goldman Sachs as a partner in senior leadership roles, including serving on the firm's Management Committee and leading its Global Sovereign Investment Banking business. During her tenure, she spearheaded some of the firm's most influential and successful economic development initiatives, including 10,000 Women, 10,000 Small Businesses and One Million Black Women—programs that have driven long-term economic growth and opportunity around the world.

In public service, Powell McCormick has served under two U.S. Presidents. She was Deputy National Security Advisor to President Donald J. Trump and a Senior White House Advisor and Assistant Secretary of State for Secretary of State Condoleezza Rice under President George W. Bush.

Most recently, Powell McCormick was Vice Chair, President and Head of Global Client Services at BDT & MSD Partners. She has been on the Board of Directors at ExxonMobil since 2024, and serves on the Board of Directors at the Robin Hood Foundation.
